ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Location:

Gurudev Kalicharan Brahma college is located at the point of the longitude 90.03652 & latitude 26.287818, in the western periphery at Tipkai under Parbartjhora sub- division of Kokrajhar District of Assam. The Kokrajhar town is at the distance of 49 km. from the college. Parbartjhora is one of the most remote sub- divisions in the district. Area was also extremely affected by the Bodo armed movement. Generally, Tipkai area is famous for greenery, surrounded by sal trees. Rupshi, the one and only Airport in Bodoland Territorial Area is 29 km from the college and famous the Mahamaya Dham of Bagribari is only 14 km from the college, vitally the Gurudham at Kazigaon the birth place of Gurudev Kalicharan Brahma, greatest social reformer of Bodos is at distance about 12 km. In fact, the nomenclature of the college is named after the great soul Gurudev Kalicharan Brahma, to disseminate his ideology, and teachings to the young generation. The college has total of 20 Bighas 0 kata and 0 Lesha land area. The beautiful natural sal tress which stands gloriously besides the campus provides a peaceful and cordial atmosphere for teaching and learning process in the institution. The area is mostly inhabited by the tribal community alongside with other sections of community.

Background of the College:

Gurudev Kalichran Brahma college the one of the pioneer higher education institution of Tipkai under Kokrajhar district of Assam. The college was established in a great public meeting held at the Tipkai Chamber House's premises under the presidentship of Late Batendra Nath Brahma, a renowned social worker and educationist of the area on 17th August 1999 with a vision to cater the need for higher education in the entire Tipkai- Parbartjhora area.

In the process of development of the college some remarkable personalities have worked hearth and soul. Some prominent personalities were Late Batendra Nath Brahma, Late Rogendra Nath Brahma, Late Torendra Nath Brahma, Torendra Basumatary, Pranendra Mushahary, Amar Chandra Brahma, Sahen chandra. Brahma, Keshab Chandra Brahma Janil

kumar Brahma, Rinkwdao Baro, Kartik chandra Saha, Sibendra Nath Brahma, Jatindra Nath Brahma, Late Nibaran Brahma, Chandra Mohan Brahma and many others.

In the inception of the college, Haribhusan Brahma was the principal i/c of the college, thereafter, Mr. Achyut Gayari also rendered service as principal i/c. and presently, Mr. Dhanrajan Lal is serving as a principal of the college. The college was initially affiliated to Gauhati University since the inception. But as Bodoland University has become full fledged university in the year 2017, the college transferred its affiliation to Bodoland University in the same year under the state act through vide order no. *BU/CUDC/AFF/08/2016-17/206 Dated 05.06.2017* temporarily and subsequently the college has received permanent affiliation from Bodoland University in the year 2022 through vide order no. *BU/CUDC/125/PER&AFF/2019/3360 Dated 03.08.2022*.

The college has also received permission for TDC examination center from Gauhati University in the year 2016 through order no. *EX/EXAM. CENTER/1/2016/2455-59 dated 26.11.2016*. but from the session 2017-2018 as the college has transferred its affiliation to Bodoland University in the same academic year college attained same academic status as of Gauhati university in Bodoland University in regard of examination center and other academic process.

The 2020 is the turning point in the history of Gurudev Kalicharan Brahma College with the signing of BTR Accord and subsequently, after surviving long 24 years in venture status with tremendous hardship and constant support from public and well-wishers the college has received much deserved provincialization by the BTC Govt. as per the 6.3 clause of the accord. On 28th December, 2023 the Chief Executive Member, (CEM) Srijt Promod Boro has distributed the appointment letters in the hand of Principals of ten (10) nos. of college including Gurudev Kalicharan Brahma College, Tipkai. With the provincialization of the college, the much anticipated and aspired dream of local public, intellectuals and well-wishers, having a higher education institution in Tipkai is realized.

ADMISSION POLICY

Gurudev Kalicharan Brahma College, Tipkai, is committed to providing inclusive and flexible education aligned with the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The college offers a holistic undergraduate programme under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), affiliated to Bodoland University. It welcomes students from diverse academic backgrounds, including Science, Commerce, and Arts, to pursue undergraduate studies in Arts disciplines.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates who have successfully completed Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination from any recognized board or council are eligible to apply.
- Students from Science or Commerce streams are also eligible to apply for any of the Arts subjects offered by the college.
- There is no restriction based on previous academic stream, in line with the multidisciplinary approach encouraged by NEP 2020.

Programme Structure

The UG Programme shall follow the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) model under NEP with the following structure:

- Year 1 & 2: Foundational and introductory courses, including multidisciplinary, skill-based and ability enhancement courses.
- Year 3: Discipline-specific courses with a focus on Major and Minor subjects.
- Year 4 (optional): Research-oriented projects or advanced courses for those pursuing Honours with Research.

Students may exit after completing:

1 year: with a Certificate

2 years: with a Diploma

3 years: with a Bachelor's Degree

4 years: with a Bachelor's Degree with Honours/Research

5. Subject Combination and Credit Allocation

- ❖ Students must choose one Major (Honours) subject from the list of offered subjects.
- ❖ In addition, students must select one or more Minor (Generic) subjects.
- ❖ Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), and Multidisciplinary/Value-Based courses will be part of the curriculum.
- ❖ Credit allocation will follow the structure prescribed by Bodoland University under the CBCS system.

Admission Procedure

- ❖ Admissions shall be conducted online or offline, as notified by the college.
- ❖ A merit-based selection process will be followed.
- ❖ Reservation policy as per Government of Assam and Bodoland University norms will be applied.
- ❖ Applicants must submit required documents including mark sheets, certificates, and identity proofs during the admission process.

Application Process

- **Mode:** Applications can be submitted **online** through the **Samarth Assam Portal**.
Applications are not collected through offline mode.
- **Required Documents (scanned for online / photocopies & originals for offline):**
 - HS (10+2) Marksheet & Certificate
 - HSLC (10th) Admit Card (for age verification)
 - Caste Certificate (if applicable)
 - EWS Certificate/ Income Certificate/ Ration Card (if applicable)
 - Disability Certificate (if applicable)
 - Gap Certificate (if applicable)
 - Recent passport-size photograph
 - Signature of the applicant
 - Domicile certificate PRC/Aadhar Card/ Caste Certificate, etc. (Any document which reflects the Applicants permanent address)
 - Ex-Servicemen Certificate (if applicable)

Selection Criteria

- **Merit-Based Admission:** Selection is purely on the basis of **marks secured in the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination**. The college will select the best of 4 subjects from the Marksheet where subject English is selected as mandatory and the marks obtained in the Subject selected for Major along with two other best scored subjects.
- Separate **merit lists** will be prepared for:
 - Major (Honours) subjects
 - General/Minor course combinations
- **Stream Flexibility:** Students from **Science and Commerce streams** are eligible for Arts subjects and will be considered equally based on their academic performance.

Publication of Merit List

- A **provisional merit list** will be published on the college website and notice board.
- In case of grievances, students may submit corrections before the **final merit list** is released.

Counselling and Subject Selection

- Selected students will be called for **counselling**, during the day of Admission which they will:
 - Confirm their **Major (Honours)** subject.
 - Choose **Minor (Generic)** subjects as per available combinations.
 - Be briefed about the FYUGP structure under NEP 2020.
- Seats will be allotted based on **availability and merit** during counselling.

Fee Payment and Admission Confirmation

- On successful counselling, students must pay the **admission fee** either:
 - **Online** through the payment gateway, or
 - **Offline** at the college office.
- The fee structure will be available in the admission notice.
- Admission will be **confirmed** only after fee payment and **document verification**.
- Applicants belonging to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) will be exempted from paying the fee.

Orientation and Commencement of Classes

- An **Orientation Programme** will be organized for newly admitted students after the Admission is over, before the start of the new session.
- Classes will begin as per the **academic calendar** issued by Bodoland University.

Reservation and Inclusivity

- ❖ The college upholds inclusive education and ensures equal opportunity for all sections of society.
- ❖ Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD and other categories will be provided as per the prevailing government rules.
- ❖ Preference will be given to students from educationally and economically backward regions of Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR).

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction shall be English, with options for regional languages (Assamese and Bodo) in language-specific courses.
